| HB 1023 | Kelly D-24 (Boone) | Increases the excise tax on cigarettes from 17 cents to 98 cents per pack of 20 cigarettes upon voter approval | 4/1/2011—Read first time (House) 4/4/2011—Read second time (House) 4/12/2011—Referred Ways and Means Committee (House) 4/21/2011 –Public Hearing Completed (House) |
| HB 719 | Higdon R-29 (Buchanan, Platte) | Requires one cent from the six cents collected and deposited into the Missouri Wine and Grape Fund to be placed in a dedicated fund for the Division of Alcohol and Tobacco Control for enforcement purposes | 3/1/2011—Read first time (House) 3/2/2011—Read second time (House) 3/16/2011—Referred: Tax Reform Committee (House) 3/30/2011—Tax Reform Committee Hearing, Public Hearing Completed |
| SB 335 | Schaaf R-34 (Buchanan, Platte) | Allows public disclosure of department of revenue records regarding the number of cigarettes sold annually by tobacco product manufacturers | 2/24/2011 – Read first time (Senate) 3/3/2011— Read Second time; Referred S General Laws Committee (Senate) |
| HB 646 | Scharnhorst R-93 (St. Louis) | Allows the annual number of cigarettes sold by each tobacco manufacturer to be disclosed by the Department of Revenue | 2/23/2011—Read first time (House) 2/24/2011 – Read second time (House) 4/12/2011—Referred: General Laws (House) |
| SB 289 | Lembke R-1 (St. Louis County, City) | Prohibits smoking or use of tobacco products in state correctional centers | 2/16/2011 – Read first time (Senate) 2/17/2011 –Read second time; Referred to General Laws Committee (Senate) |
| HB491 | Diehl R-87 (St. Louis Co.) | Changes the requirements regarding when funds can be released from escrow accounts under the Tobacco Master Settlement Agreement. | 2/10/2011—Read first time (House) 2/14/2011—Read second time (House) 2/24/2011 – Referred to General Laws Committee (H) 3/8/2011— General Laws Committee Hearing (House) |

| HB438 | Schupp D-82 (St. Louis Co.) | Repeals the Indoor Clean Air Act and enacts new provisions to make workplaces and public places smokefree statewide. | 2/8/2011—Read first time (House) 2/9/2011—Read second time (House) 2/24/2011 - Referred: Local Government (House) 3/9/2011 – Local Government Committee Hearing; Public Hearing Completed (House) |
| HB343 | Still D-25 (Columbia) | Increases the current excise tax on cigarettes of 17 cents per pack of 20 cigarettes by 12.5 cents per pack per year for eight years until the excise tax on cigarettes reaches \$1.17 per pack | 1/27/2011—Read first time (House) 1/31/2011 – Read second time (House) 4/12/2011- Referred Ways and Means Committee (House) |
| HB342 | Still D-25 (Columbia) | Increases the cigarette tax by \$1.17 per pack upon a vote of the people | 1/27/2011—Read first time (House) 1/31/2011 – Read second time (House) 4/12/2011- Referred Ways and Means Committee (House) |
| HB 314 | Wells R-147 (Texas, Phelps, Pulaski, Shannon, Frederick) | Repeals a school district's authority to set policies allowing the use of tobacco products in certain school areas and prohibits smoking and the use of tobacco products on all school property and school buses | 1/25/2011—Read first time (House) 1/26/2011 – Read second time (House) 2/10/2011 – Referred to Elementary and Secondary Education (House) 4/5/2011 - Public Hearing Completed (House) |

| HB 225 | Brandom R-160 (Cape Girardeau, New Madrid, Scott) | Classifies tobacco blunt wraps as drug paraphernalia | 1/18/2011—Read first time (House) 1/19/2011 – Read second time (House) 1/20/2011 – Referred: Crime Prevention and Public Safety (House) 2/24/2011 – Withdrawn (House) |
| HB 181 | Nasheed D-60 (St. Louis City) | Increases the excise tax on cigarettes from 17 cents to 33 cents per pack of 20 cigarettes to be deposited, less a 3% collection fee, into the General Revenue Fund | 1/12/2011—Read first time (House) 1/13/2011 – Read second time (House) 4/12/2011- Referred Ways and Means Committee (House) |
| HB 63 | Curls D-41 (Kansas City, Jackson Co. area) | Prohibits any employee of a seller of cigarettes or tobacco products who is younger than 18 years of age from selling cigarettes or tobacco products in the course of his or her employment. | 1/5/2011—Read first time (House) 1/6/2011 – Read second time (House) 3/3/2011 – Referred: Small Business 3/16/2011 – Small Business Committee Hearing - Bill not heard |
