



Tobacco-related bills filed in Missouri in 2012 (Updated 1/18/12)

Bill*	Sponsor	Summary	Last Actions
SB 523	Curls D-9 (Jackson Co.)	Prohibits persons under the age of 18 from selling tobacco products.	1/18/2012 – Hearing Conducted S Commerce, Consumer Protection, Energy and the Environment Committee
SB 629	Schaefer R-19 (Boone & Randolph Cos.)	Modifies the formula for determining how much money certain tobacco product manufacturers who are not participating in the Tobacco Master Settlement Agreement receive back from escrow funds.	1/9/2012 – Introduced and First Read (Senate)
SB 638	Lamping R-24 (St. Louis Co.)	This act increases Missouri's excise tax on cigarettes from seventeen cents per pack to forty-three cents per pack beginning August 28, 2012. The revenue derived from the twenty-six cent increase will be deposited in the general revenue fund.	1/10/2012 - First Read (Senate)
SB 664	Chappelle-Nadal D-14 (St. Louis Co.)	This act modifies the provisions of the Missouri Indoor Clean Air Act to prohibit smoking in a public place or a public meeting or within fifteen feet of any entrance to a public place or public meeting. The definition of public place has been amended to include any building or vehicle owned, leased or operated by a governmental entity as well as bars and restaurants. The provision allowing for a designated smoking area in public places has been repealed.	1/17/2012 – Read First Time (House)
HB 1136	Molendorp R-123 (Cass Co.)	Prohibits any person from smoking or using tobacco products in any area or on the grounds of a state correctional facility beginning July 1, 2013.	1/5/2012 – Read Second Time (House)

HB 1223	Brattin R-124 (Cass Co.)	Changes various practices at correctional facilities, including restoring hard labor and chain gangs, and prohibiting smoking, certain entertainment, and exercise equipment.	1/12/2012 – Referred: Crime Prevention and Public Safety (H)
HB 1352	Schupp D-82 (St. Louis Co.)	Repeals the Indoor Clean Air Act and establishes new laws regarding smoking in public places	1/18/2012 – Introduced and Read First Time (H)
